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On 8/24/2023, I responded to 11270 SW Town Park Ave (Town Park Clubhouse) in reference to a civil matter. The caller stated that she was not being allowed into the clubhouse to speak with an employee named Logan regarding a verbal disturbance he had with her son.

At the scene, Ofc. Penney #1190 made contact with the reporting party, [REDACTED]. It should be noted for the purposes of this report that [REDACTED] is a sworn law enforcement officer with the Port St. Lucie Police Department; I immediately notified Sgt. Zamoyski #454 of this contact. [REDACTED] stated that her son, [REDACTED], had called her because he had been in a verbal altercation with an employee at the clubhouse named Logan. Kim came to the clubhouse to attempt to speak with Logan, and on arrival Logan would not allow her to enter the clubhouse and speak with him. [REDACTED] stated that she has an old key card and was unable to gain entry, so she called law enforcement. After calling law enforcement, a witness to the incident informed [REDACTED] that during the course of the incident, Logan had taken a holstered firearm from behind the desk and placed it into his waistband.

While Ofc. Penney was speaking with [REDACTED] OIT Nigh #1238 made contact with Logan Bottorff (suspect/ victim). Logan Bottorff submitted a sworn written statement which stated the following:

"It was around 6-7 PM 8/24/23 was approached earlier in the night by a homeowner stating that the kids in this case were the ones harassing and threatening everyone a few weeks back. The kids were trying to get into the clubhouse without an access ID card. We have signs posted all over stating we are not allowed to let anyone in without an active access ID card. Another homeowner approached the front door told the kids he can't let them in talked for about a minute or 2 before the homeowner entered and the kids snuck in behind him. That's when I told the kid to leave multiple times he would never listen. The kids started moving towards the other door. He started threatening me telling he's going to open the door and let his friends in to jump me. After that for my safety I went back to my desk grabbed my gun and put it in my waistband facing away from everyone and didn't touch it since I am a CCW holder.

I did get loud in the argument with the kid.

Little while later the mom and kid shows up banging on the door to be let in they didn't have their card so they got mad and called the cops."

I asked Logan Bottorff if he served Town Park as a security guard, and he stated that he did not. I asked him if Town Park permitted him to be armed while he was working, and he stated that they were aware and had not told him that he could not be armed. He provided me with a valid Florida concealed weapons license. Logan Bottorff stated that he retrieved the firearm in response to the threat that the juvenile male would be bringing a group in to "jump" him. He explained that he carries his Glock 30 .45 ACP handgun (S/N BRG4751; NCIC/FCIC clear) in a leather "sidecar" (holster with attached spare magazine pouch) style appendix in-waistband holster. "Appendix carry" refers to carrying a concealed firearm along the front portion of the waistband), and as such it is uncomfortable to keep in his waistband while seated for prolonged periods, so he will store it in a cupboard at the front desk of the clubhouse. Logan Bottorff also stated that when he retrieved the firearm, he made every effort to keep it concealed from public view by facing a wall and covering it with his shirt. He denied ever brandishing the firearm or making any threats with it. Logan Bottorff described the juvenile male in this incident as wearing a black shirt and blue shorts, consistent with [REDACTED] apparel on scene.

After clearing the initial call for service, Logan Bottorff contacted me again telephonically via the Port St. Lucie Police Department PSS division. He stated that he neglected to include in his original statement that prior to threatening to jump him, [REDACTED] had "poked" him in the chest with his finger. Logan Bottorff did not allege any injury, but stated that he understood per Florida Statute that any unwanted touch or strike constituted a battery. I explained to Logan Bottorff that I would document these allegations, and that he could provide an additional sworn written statement during follow-up investigations tomorrow.

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While I was speaking to Logan Bottorff on scene, Town Park property manager Susan Rak called the front desk phone and requested to speak with me. Susan Rak stated that there were ongoing issues with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at the clubhouse. I notified Sgt. Zamoyski of her concerns and had him come to speak with her. Susan Rak was provided with the agency case number for her reference. Logan Bottorff did not have access to review the security footage on scene, but Susan Rak stated that she would compile this footage and make herself available in the afternoon of 8/25/23 for me to collect it.

[REDACTED] also submitted a sworn written statement which reads as follows:
 "Logan wouldn't let me in so I asked some guy to let me in but when I walked he started yelling `get the fuck out` and I asked what I did and then he got up and started getting in my face screaming and then he goes back behind the desk and grabs a gun and puts it in his waist and then proceeds to yell in my face and then I said if he puts his hands on me that there's gonna be a big problem for him and then he just keeps screaming then finally I just left and he also was yelling at my friend as I was walking out."

Upon learning that [REDACTED] was also a suspect in this incident, [REDACTED] invoked his 5th amendment rights on his behalf as his guardian and advised him not to speak with us further without legal counsel. [REDACTED] made multiple attempts against her advice to try and speak with us further, but did not add any information of value.

Also present at the clubhouse was Vikas Gupta (witness) who provided a sworn written statement which read as follows:
 "Around 6:55 PM on 8/24/23, as I was about to enter the HOA gym, I overheard the exiting person telling two teenage boys that they are not allowed entry to the HOA gym as per the front desk person. As I tried to enter one teenage boy tried to enter with me even though I asked him not to. He then followed me as I temporarily returned back to the parking lot. I asked him what was the issue. He said he was a resident at Fieldstone and did not have the card to allow him entry to HOA gym and that all he wanted was to talk and explain this to the front desk. He then followed me into the HOA gym and was immediately asked to leave by front desk person. This led to an escalating verbal argument where he refused to leave despite multiple times after being asked by front desk person to do so."

Michael Roberts (witness) was also present on scene and completed a sworn written statement which read as follows:
 "Walked in clubhouse, went to front desk. Then a boy walked in from East side door. Then man behind front desk starting cursing at this boy telling him to get the `fuck out` several times. They kept verbally going back and forth, then man behind desk grabbed he said to be gun put in his shirt and went towards boy. They continued to argue before I intervened and told boy to go home and have parents address the issue. Then when the worker came back to desk I ask if that was a gun he grabbed he said yes."

Michael Roberts also captured a video of part of the incident. He was provided an Axon community request link and uploaded it to Evidence.com. I am unable to determine whether the battery alleged by Logan Bottorff occurred from this video as the video partway into the incident, after the battery was alleged to have occurred. In the video, Logan Bottorff can be seen arguing with [REDACTED] and another teenage boy near the East door of the clubhouse. It is difficult to make out exactly what is being said, but Logan Bottorff can be heard saying "bet, bet, bet" as he returns to the front desk area. In the background, [REDACTED] can be heard saying "ok so it's my fault if I said me and my friend are gonna fight you if you hit me because you're getting in my face? Call the cops, I'd like to see what... you're like 40 dude!". During this time, Logan Bottorff goes behind the front desk, reaches into a cabinet, and retrieves his holstered firearm. The firearm is momentarily seen on camera before he tucks it into his waistband and covers it with his shirt. Logan Bottorff then begins to look at his cell phone as he returns from behind the front desk. The pair then continue arguing in the main hallway of the clubhouse, standing across from one another at a small table. Their conversation is as follows:

Logan: I'm 40?

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█: You`re threatening me. I`m like 15 bro!

Logan: So you think you`re cool? You think you`re a punk? You already know what you did. I already had two residents that were in here, the guy that walked outside ID`ed you, told me you were in here! You`re on the cameras, I`ve watched the cameras, you`re on the film! You have a police report!

█: A police report for what? A police report for what?

Logan: Cause you came in here, you caused a big-ass fucking scene in the gym

█: I didn`t cause a scene

Logan: And then you went inside, next door

The video cuts out mid-argument. At no point during the video is Logan observed brandishing the firearm or otherwise threatening █ or the other juvenile. No party in the video makes any statement acknowledging Logan having armed himself.

I also briefly spoke again to █ stated that she had received an additional video from Michael Roberts via text message. I provided Kim Bailey with an Axon community request link to upload this footage to Evidence.com. On review of her submission, I saw that this was the same video as previously described.

At this time, there is insufficient evidence to determine whether a criminal act occurred. Logan Bottorff has made allegations of assault and battery against █, and █ has made allegations of a weapons violation by Logan Bottorff. I will be following up to collect additional video footage on my next working day. I was unable to locate any prior incidents involving █ at the Town Park clubhouse, although it appears Logan Bottorff may have been referencing incident# 230715301 from 7/11/23, in which 3 juveniles at the gym were harassing the ladies at the bingo game.

Sgt. Zamoyski #454 was notified of this incident and responded to the scene.

"After giving my original statement I realized I forgot to add that during the argument with the kid, the kid poked me in the chest which is an unlawful unwanted touch and battery. The mother of the kid came to the clubhouse trying to get in she then called the clubhouse phone. Was very nasty with me saying I'm a cop let me the fuck in I own you I pay your bills I pay your check I own this fucking clubhouse and continued to curse at me threatened to call the cops. I told her to and hung up. The mom is Officer [REDACTED]."

I asked Logan Bottorff if Susan Rak was still on scene to provide me with video footage, and he stated that she had left for the day. I made contact with Susan Rak telephonically, and she stated that she had not yet been able to get the footage together and would have to contact the security company to obtain the requested footage. I provided Susan Rak with the case number again and requested that she notify me when the footage was available for pickup by contacting the Port St. Lucie Police Department. She stated that she anticipated she would be able to complete this task on Monday, 8/28/23.

A copy of this photo was uploaded to Evidence.com. I replied to this email and informed [REDACTED] of my actions.

I also received a message via the Police Service Specialist division requesting that I call [REDACTED] in regards to this case. I attempted to contact her via my agency-issued cell phone, and the call went to voicemail. I left [REDACTED] a message requesting that she contact me if she needed further assistance with this case.

On 9/14/23, I responded to 11270 SW Town Park Ave to obtain security footage from this incident as discussed with Susan Rak. At the scene, I was provided with a USB drive containing security footage from the incident, as well as a video driver for playback.

I reviewed the video footage and observed the following:

At 18:47, [REDACTED] and another juvenile in a green shirt and black shorts with red hair curly come to the front door of the clubhouse and attempt to gain access. They repeatedly knock at the door for approximately 2 minutes.

At 18:50, the juveniles speak with Vikas Gupta at the front door and request to be let in.

At 18:53, [REDACTED] follows Vikas Gupta into the clubhouse via the front door. Upon entering the clubhouse, he is immediately confronted at the front desk by Logan Bottorff, who appears to gesture for him to leave, then comes around the desk and opens the front door, gesturing again for him to exit. This argument appears to continue for a prolonged period. Logan Bottorff also attempts to have [REDACTED] exit via the East door to the building.

At 18:55:35, [REDACTED] is observed standing in the main lobby near the East wing of the building, facing the front desk. At this time Logan Bottorff approaches him, repeatedly yelling and gesturing for him to get out. During this confrontation, Logan Bottorff closes distance with [REDACTED] while [REDACTED] is actively gesturing with his hands. Due to the camera angle, I am unable to observe whether any physical contact occurs between the two, but it appears that any contact would have been incidental and precipitated by Logan Bottorff's proximity to [REDACTED].

At 18:56, Logan Bottorff is observed going behind the front desk and retrieving his firearm, facing away from other parties on scene and actively making an effort to conceal it. He then returns to the lobby and confronts [REDACTED] again, who proceeds down the East wing of the building towards the lanai area. The pair continues to argue at the Lanai door until [REDACTED] ultimately exits and Logan Bottorff shuts the door behind him. At 1900 hours, [REDACTED] has completely exited the building and is seen standing on the lanai with the other juvenile, apparently making a phone call. Throughout events described above, the other juvenile was observed standing on the lanai area, apparently waiting to be let into the building.

The surveillance footage continues beyond the incident until [REDACTED] arrives at the clubhouse. This footage is not described in this report as it is unrelated to the criminal allegations in this case. The surveillance footage did not reveal any major inconsistencies with the totality of circumstances as previously described by all parties on scene.

The USB Drive containing this footage was submitted to evidence. I also recorded a portion of the video on my agency-issued cell phone and uploaded it to evidence.com via the Axon capture app for review.

Upon review of the surveillance footage from this incident, I have concluded my investigation into this matter. With regards to the allegations of a weapons violation by Logan Bottorff, I am unable to find probable cause that any violation of Florida Statute occurred. Logan Bottorff lawfully possessed his firearm and did not brandish it or threaten any party on scene during the incident. With regards to the allegations of battery by [REDACTED], I did not observe any action that would violate F.S. 784.03(1A1) on the surveillance footage. The allegations in this case are therefore unfounded, and this case will be closed with a status of unfounded.
